"My God, my God, why have you forsaken me? Why are you so far from helping me, from the words of my groaning? Oh my God, I cry by day, but you do not answer; and by night, but find no rest." Psalm 22

My Dear Congregation,

Jesus cried the first words from Psalm 22 when he was close to death on the cross. "My God, my God, why have you forsaken me? When things are bad or terrifying or when there is no other way to express the lack of hope we may be feeling there is Psalm 22. It seesaws back and forth between abject hopelessness and a deep faith the God is always present and will prevail.

While I was away on vacation in the sunny Florida Keys life still went on. War still happened in Gaza and Ukraine. People still perished from draught and starvation. The world is still plagued by climate changes that we human beings have caused. And God is still present.

I usually try to write something upbeat for the Steeple but this month could we pay attention to those things that are happening in the world and surround the suffering of people and places with our prayer? There is so much sorrow in the world. There are so many people who need. The earth itself is crying out.

Take a look at Psalm 22. Would you, for the next week, find a time to pray this psalm every day? I will pray with the early risers at 6:00. It won't take long. Light a candle for the world and sit in a comfy chair and just read the psalm slowly to yourself. Close your eyes for a few minutes and let any images that come into your mind sit with you. Pray for anyone or any situation that might make itself known. Be with those people and places in your mind. Know that our witness and presence are powerful things.

It may not seem like we are doing anything very much but to pray the world safe is a huge undertaking. Stay with it. The world needs your prayers.
